### **Membership Agreement**

The University of Western Australia Torpedoes Water Polo Club ("UWA Torpedoes") participates only in Australian National Water Polo competitions and aims to be a top ranking team in these competitions. The UWA Torpedoes support all levels of player development by providing first class coaching and pool space at the UWA Pool.

The following is a list of commitments expected of all members.

1. All members must register and pay their respective annual membership category fee to become a current financial member of the UWA Torpedoes Water Polo Club Inc.
2. A playing member must also be a financial member of an affiliated Club with the Western Australian Water Polo Inc and therefore have a current WAWPI registration identification number.
3. All members and their families must support the club in its fundraising activities, or pay the associated alternative levy.
4. A playing member must conform to the Code of Conduct for Players
5. A playing member must attend training and other development sessions as required by the Coach, and must inform the coach of injury or any other circumstances which may prevent their participation at training or in competition. Repetitive failure to satisfy this requirement may result in the player being released from the UWA Torpedoes Squad and another player being invited to join the team.
6. Unless the UWA Torpedoes Committee has granted you an exception based on your unique circumstances, a junior playing member (18 & Under), accepts unconditionally that they will make themselves available to be selected in any UWA Torpedoes team participating in a National Age Group Championship. Failure to do so may result in you being released from the UWA Torpedoes Squad and another player being invited to join the team.

By becoming a member of the UWA Torpedoes, I have read and understood the terms and conditions of this Membership Agreement and agree to abide by all of the club's rules and Code of Conduct.
